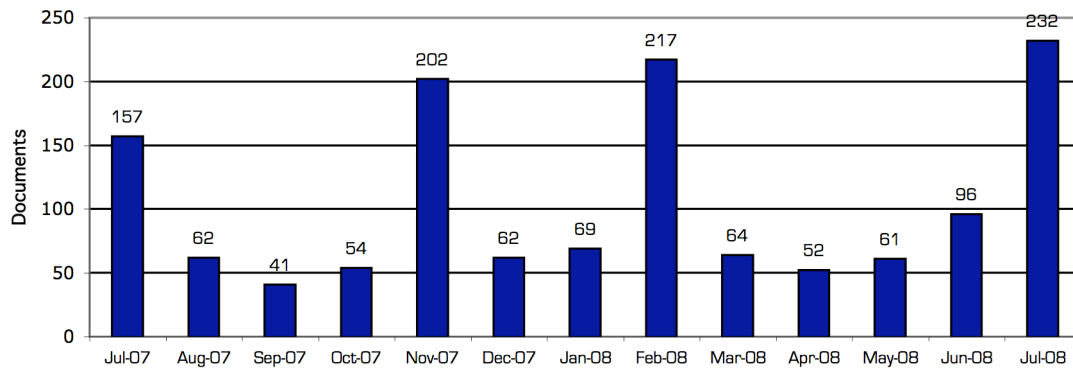

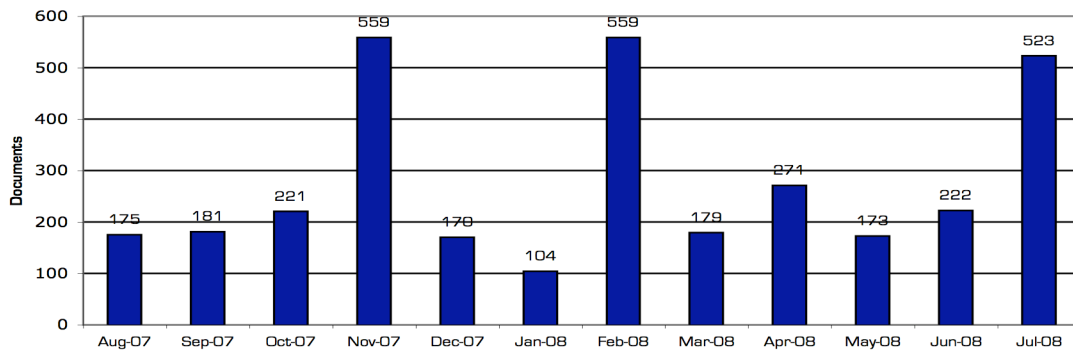

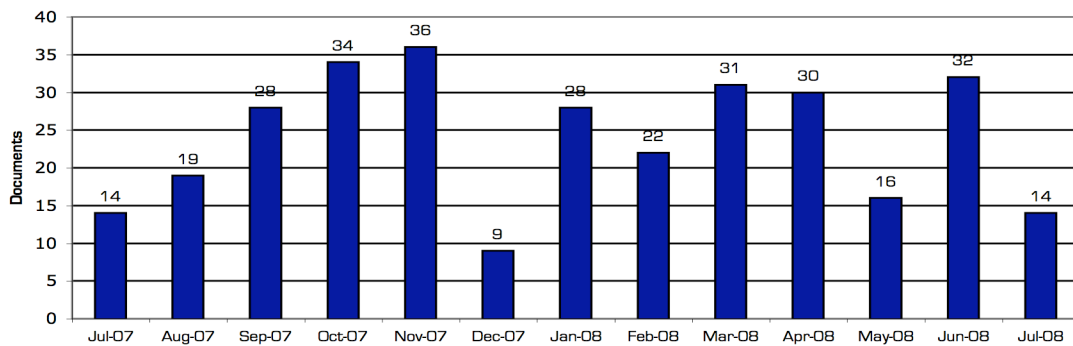
New Internet Draft Activity 2007-2008



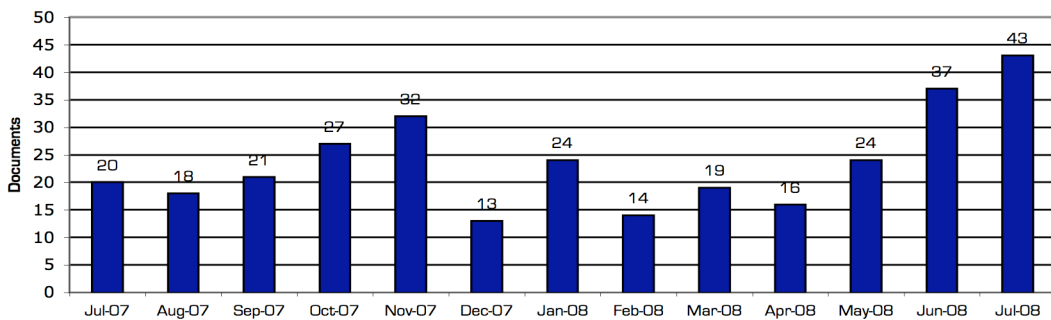
Revised or Updated Internet Drafts 2007-2008
