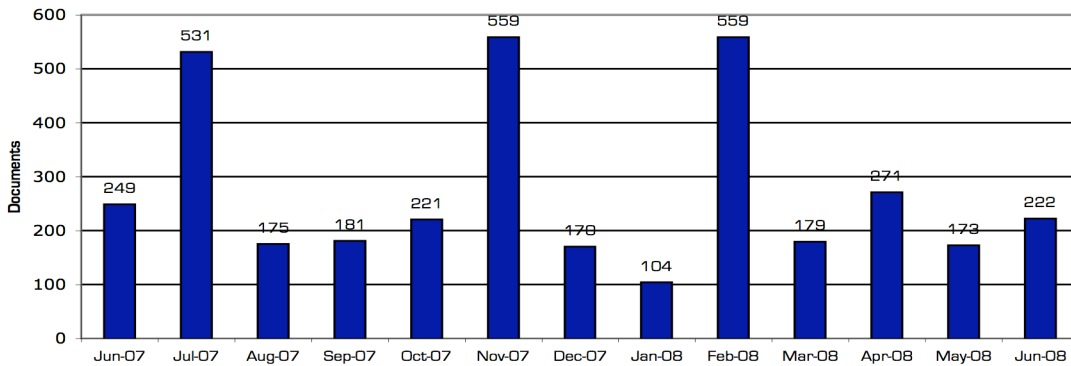

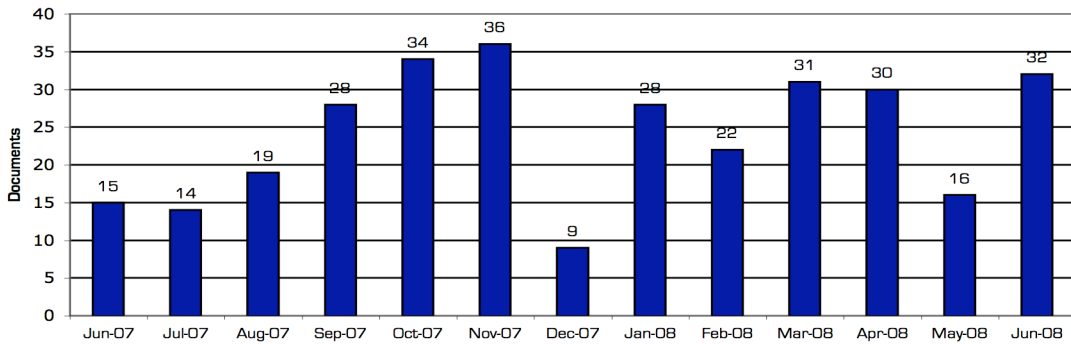
**New Internet Draft Activity 2007-2008**



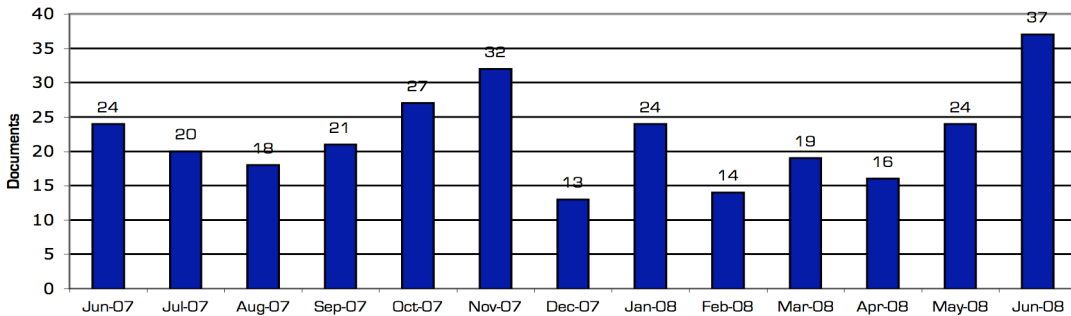

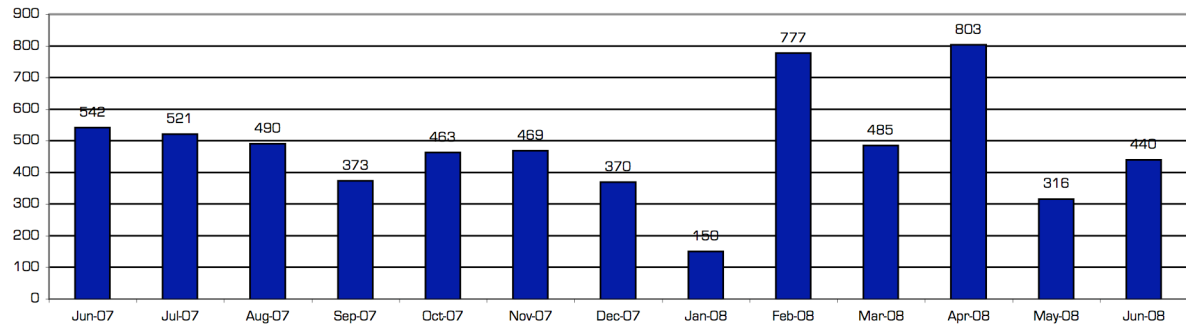

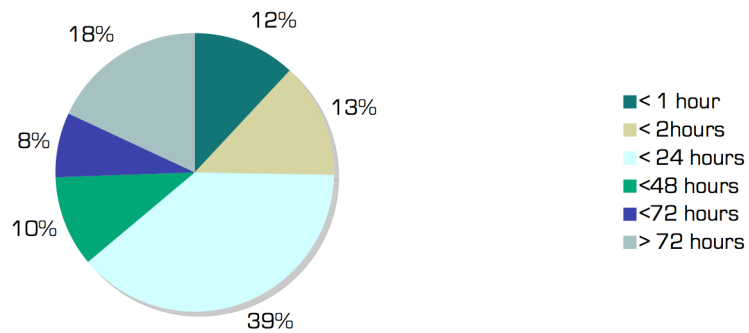

As of June 30, 2008

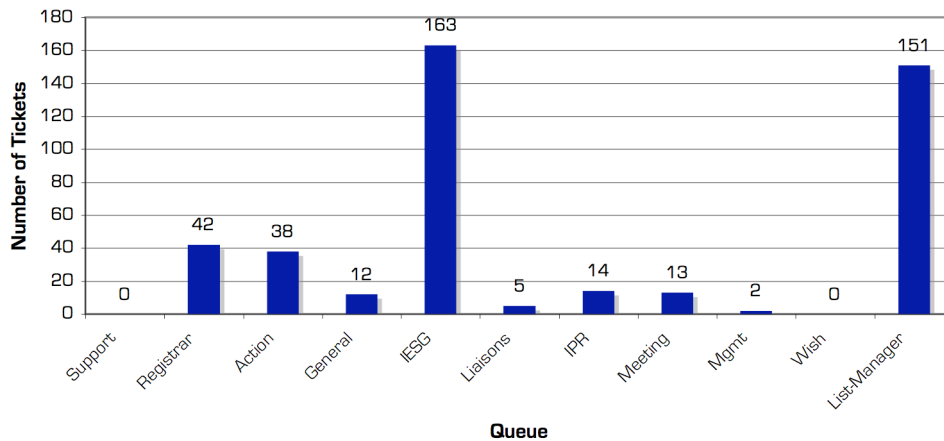
### Tickets Resolved 2007-2008



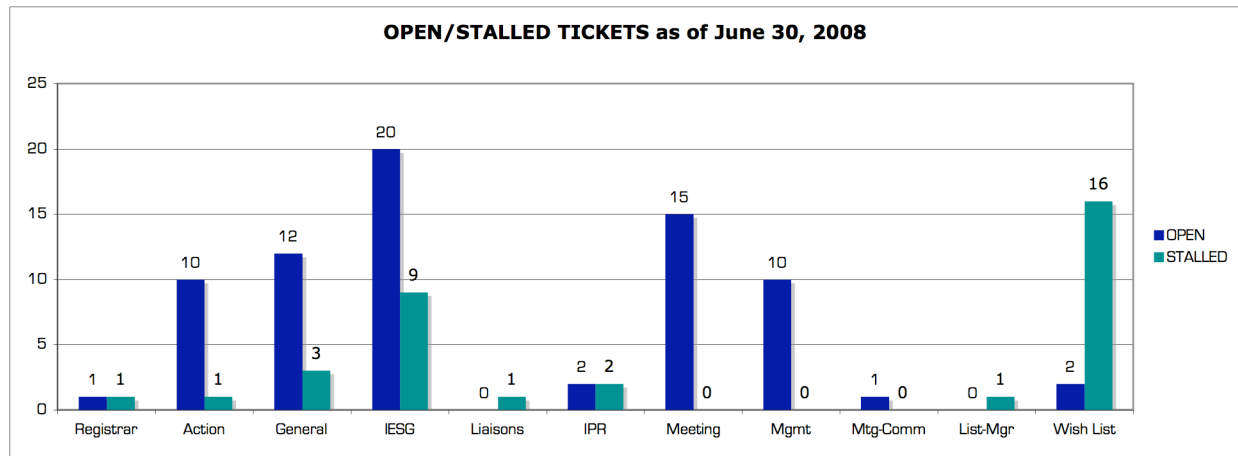
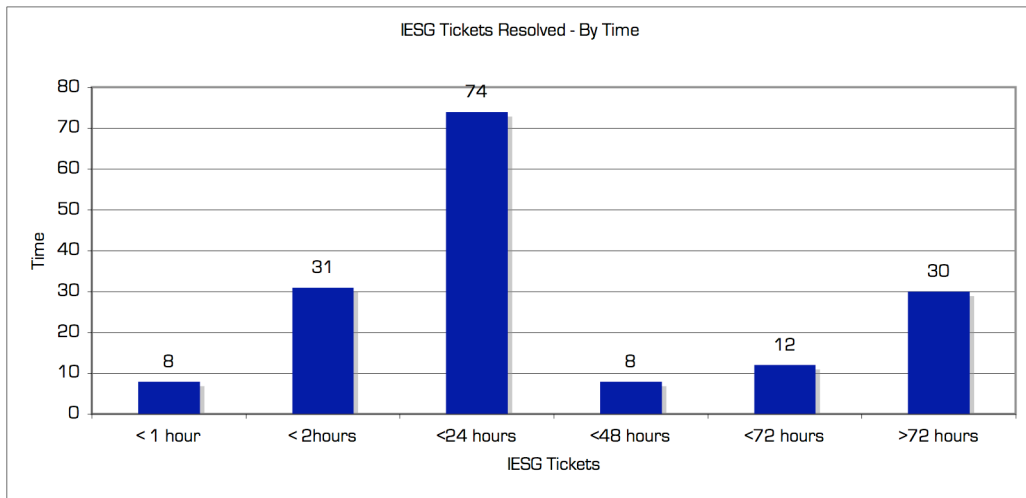
### 440 Tickets Resolved - By Time



### 440 Tickets Resolved - By Queue

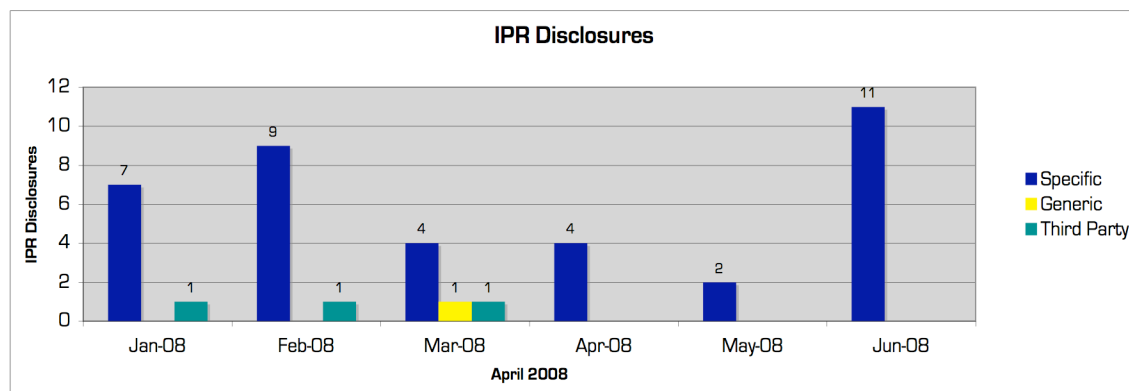

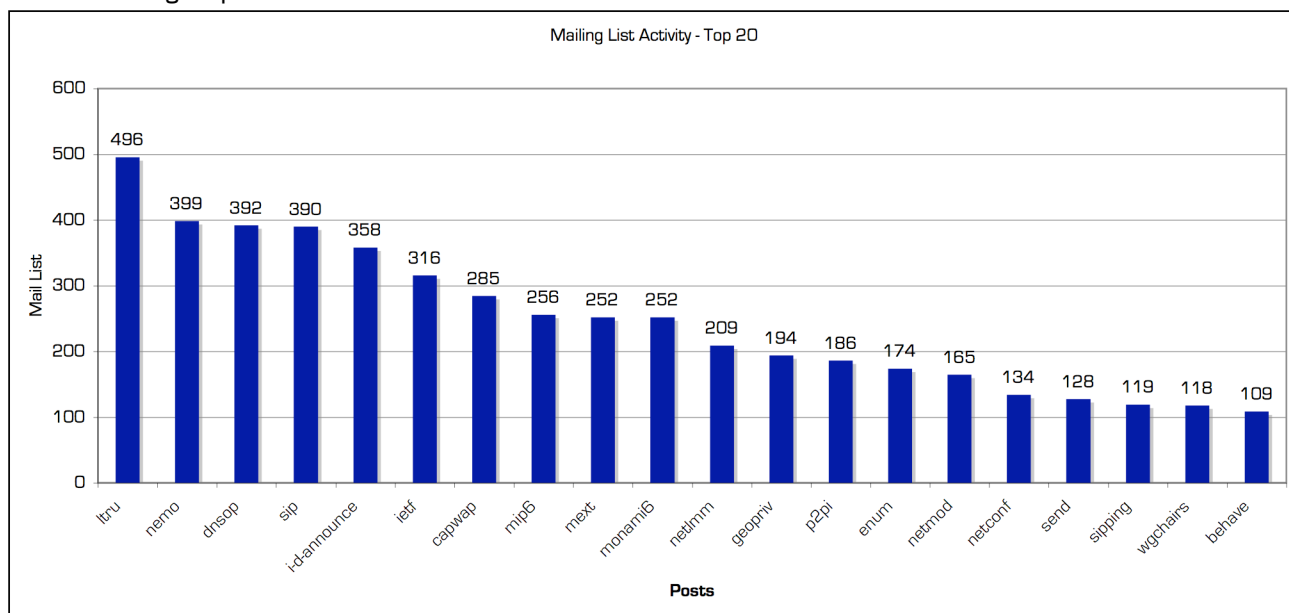
