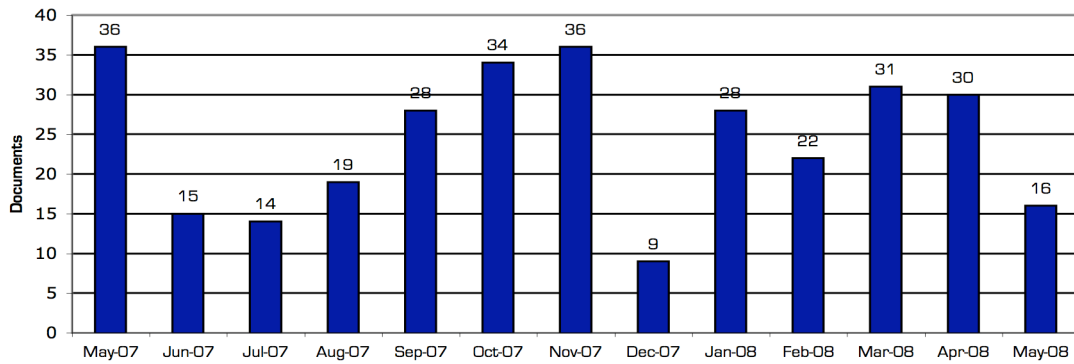
New Internet Draft Activity 2007-2008



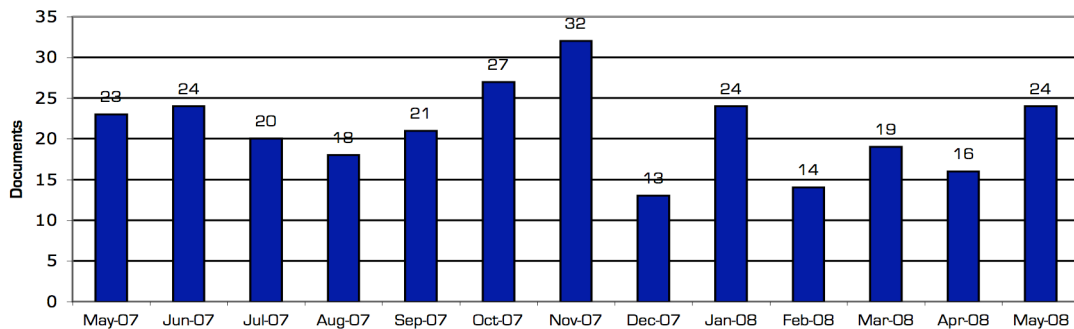
Revised or Updated Internet Drafts 2007-2008

IETF Ticket Management As of May 31, 2008

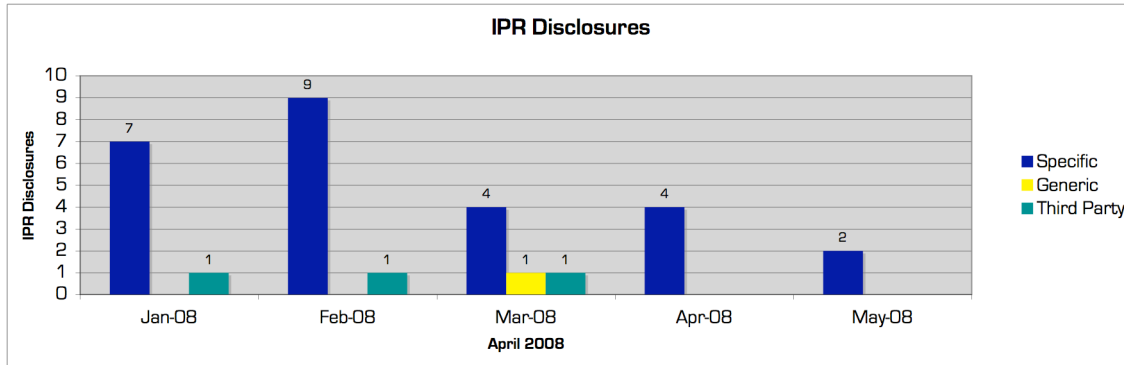

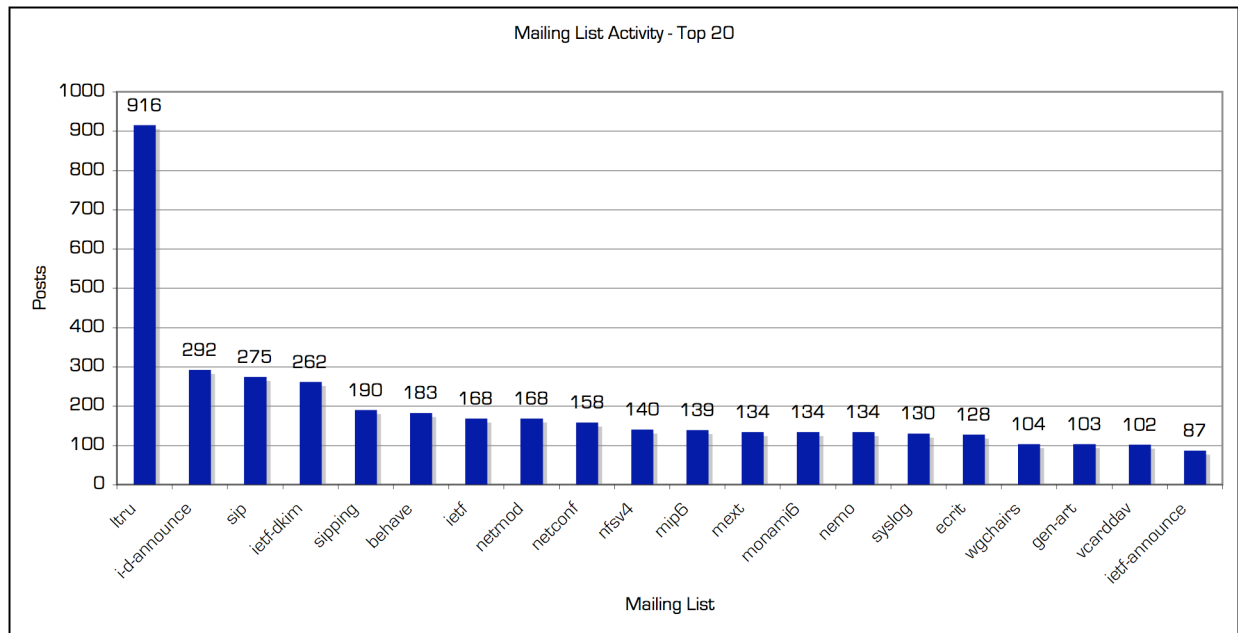

Set up of new jabber server	Setting up new Jabber server for use at the Dublin meeting. Working with Jabber developers to create patches for existing software issues. Testing will be performed one month prior to the Dublin event to ensure stability of server.	IN PROGRESS
Modification and management of new spam controls	Identified and analyzed reported problem with users not being able to send to IETF servers/lists. Problem turned out to be poorly-configured client on remote end being rejected by aggressive spam rules on server end. Disabled those rules temporarily; then, in coordination with IETF staff, re-enabled subset of those rules and set up and provided a web-based form for rejected people to use to reach secretariat staff for access white-listing when their mail was being rejected. Installation of new bypass web form for secretariat contacts	Created webform for users to use to notify secretariat of issues involving IETF email.	COMPLETE
