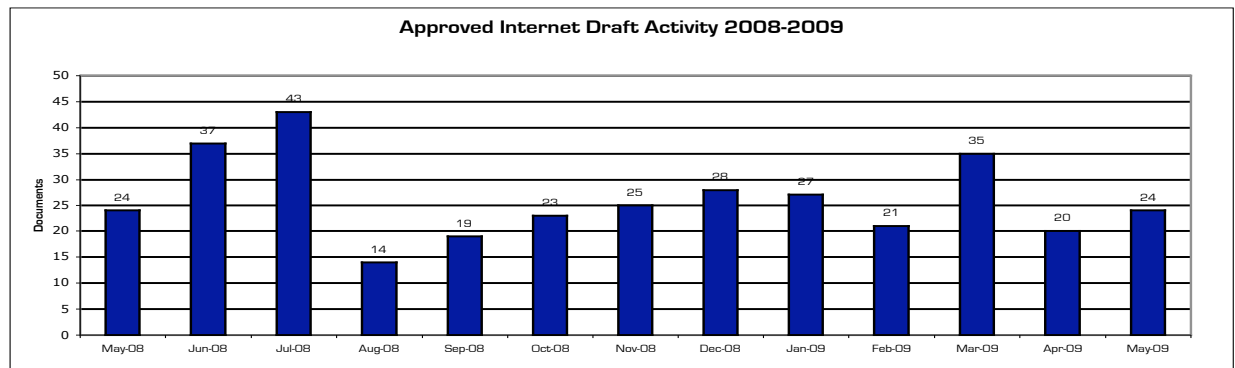
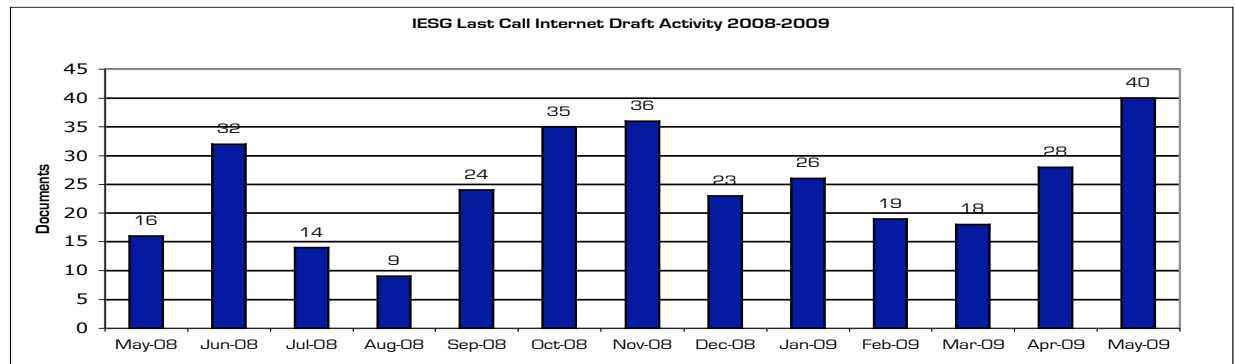
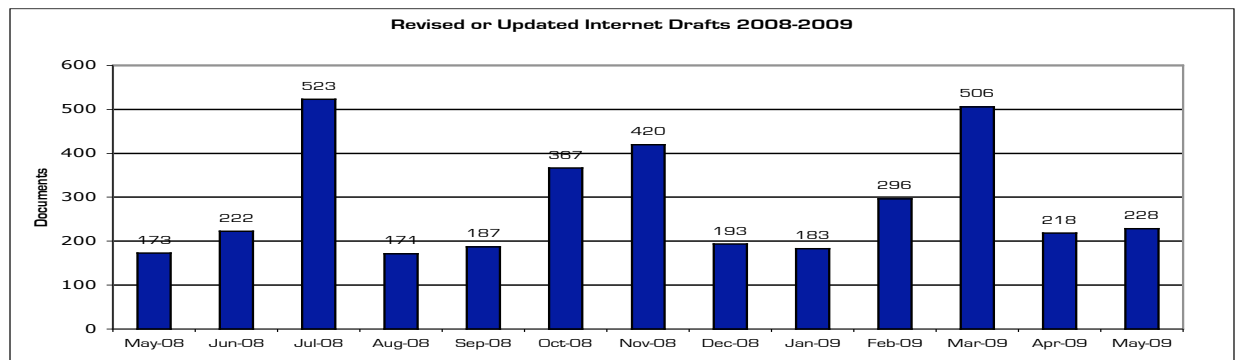
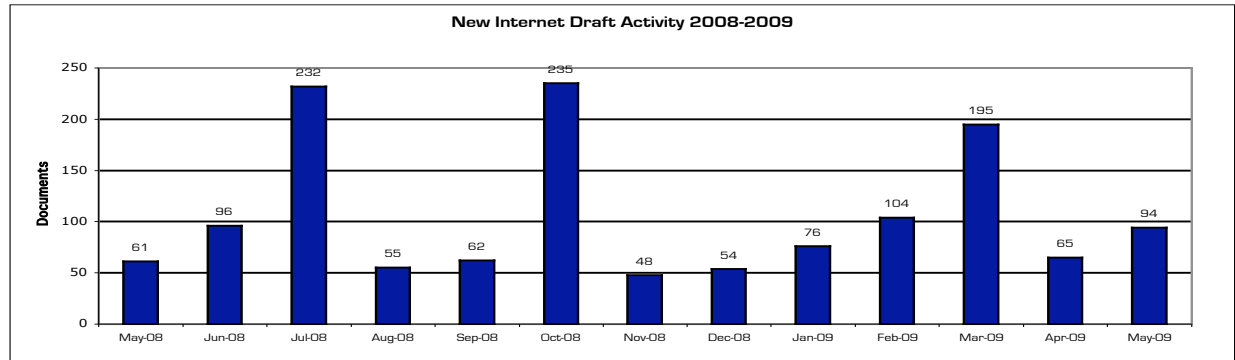


**LOIs Issued IETF 75

IETF Ticket Management (TOTAL TICKETS)

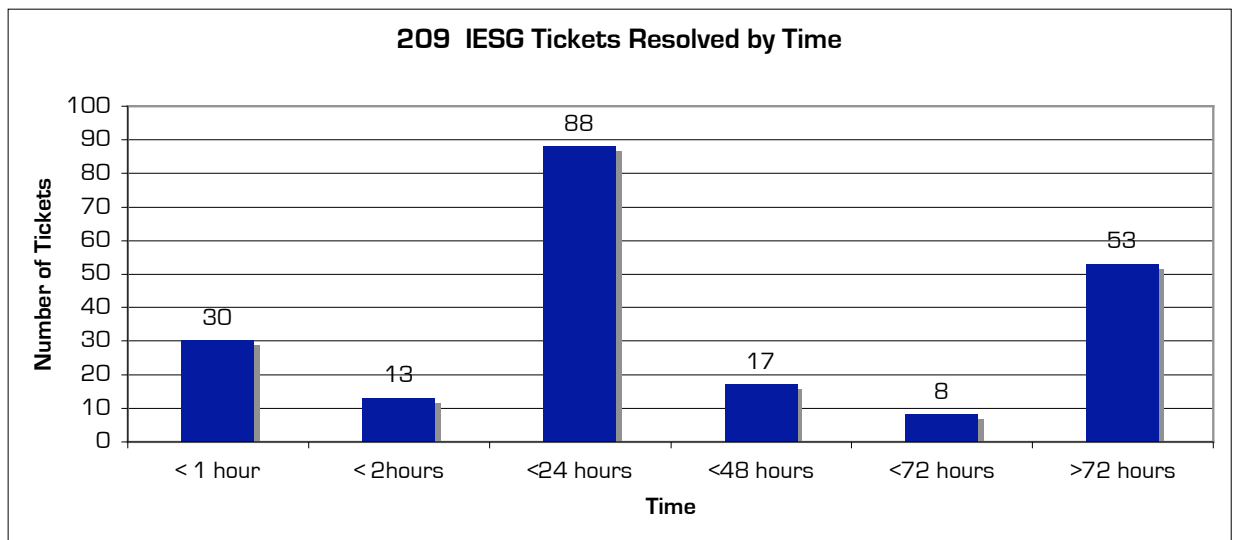

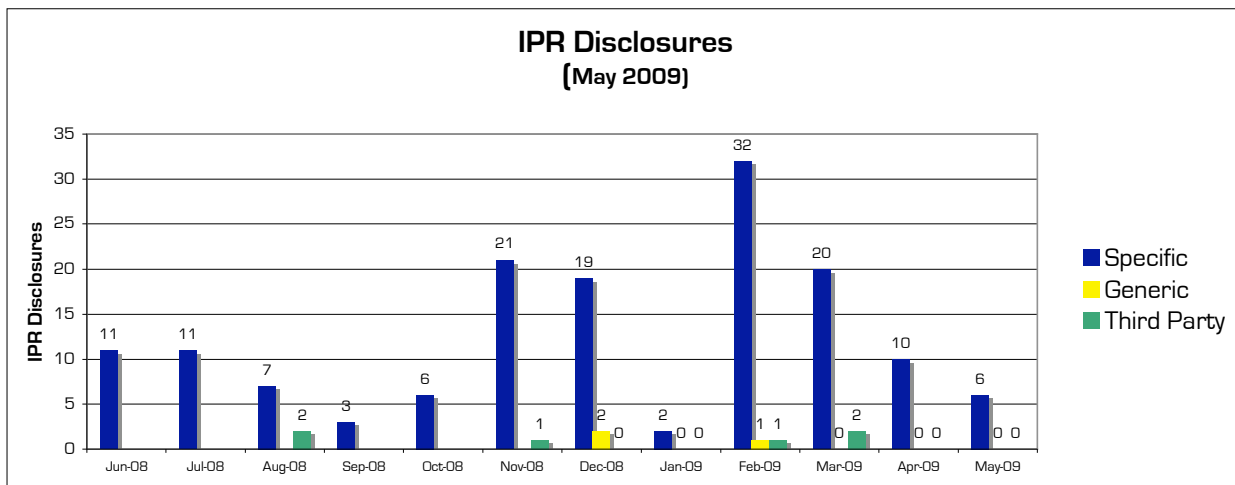


IETF Ticket Management (IESG TICKETS)

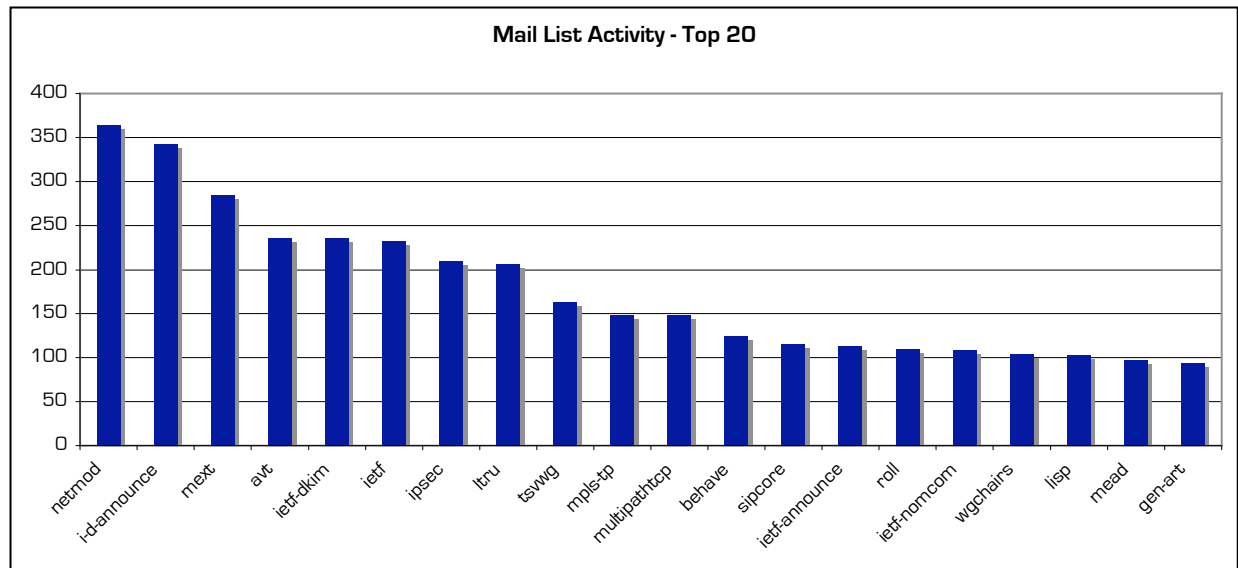
