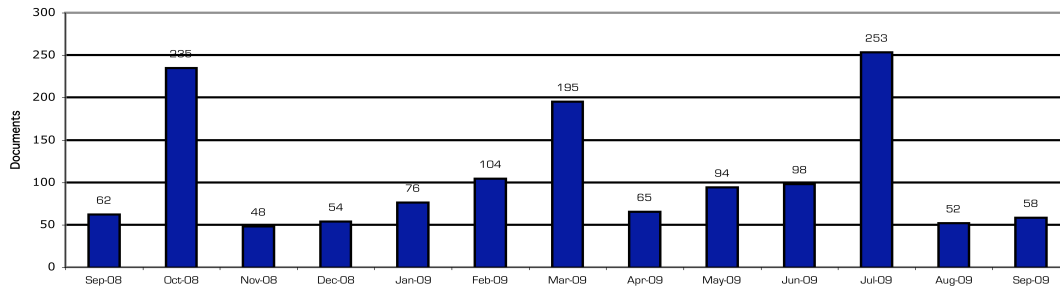

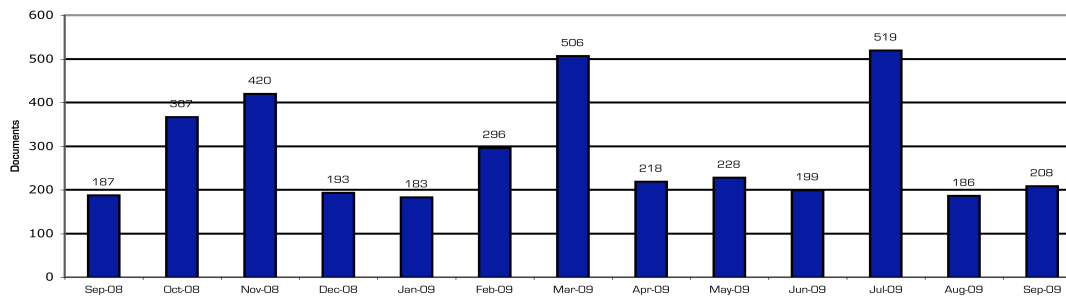

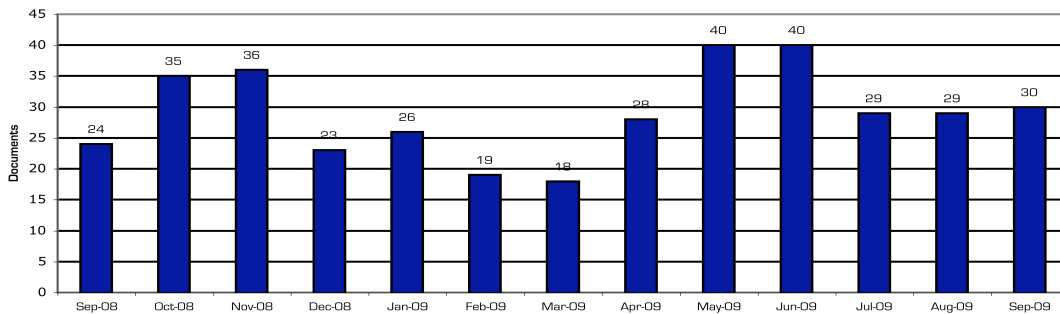
New Internet Draft Activity 2008-2009



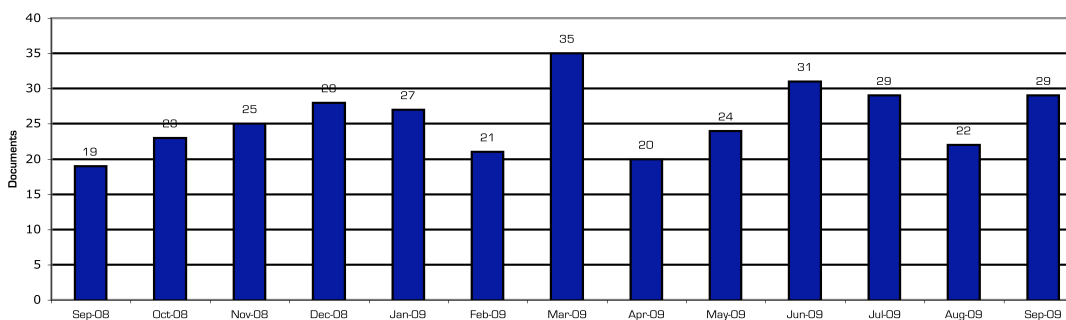
Revised or Updated Internet Drafts 2008-2009

IETF Ticket Management (TOTAL TICKETS)

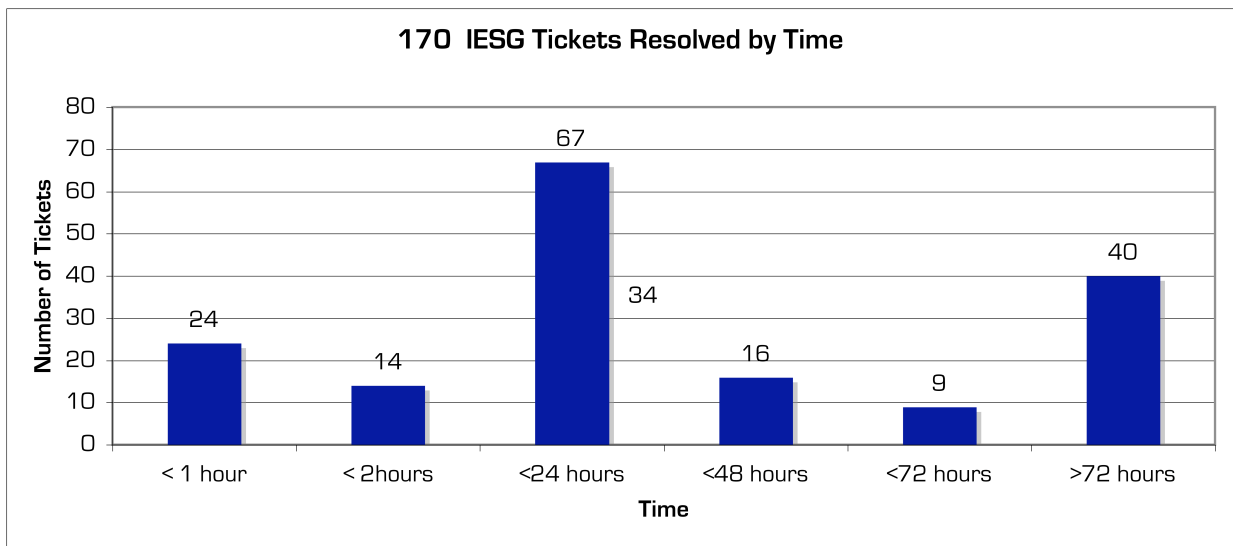

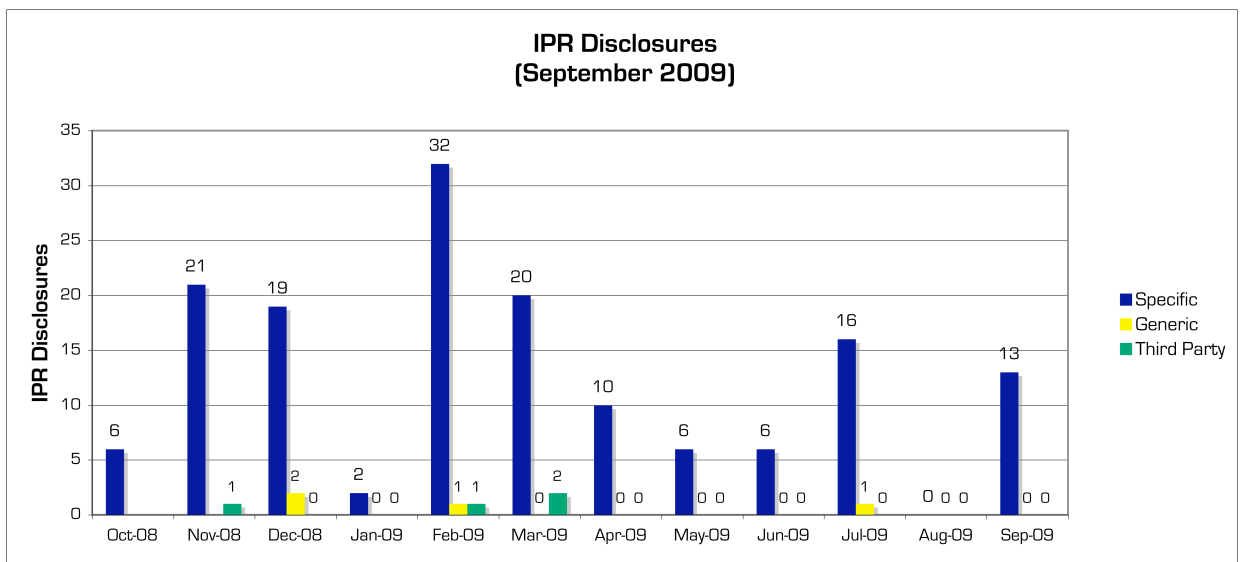


IETF Ticket Management (IESG TICKETS)

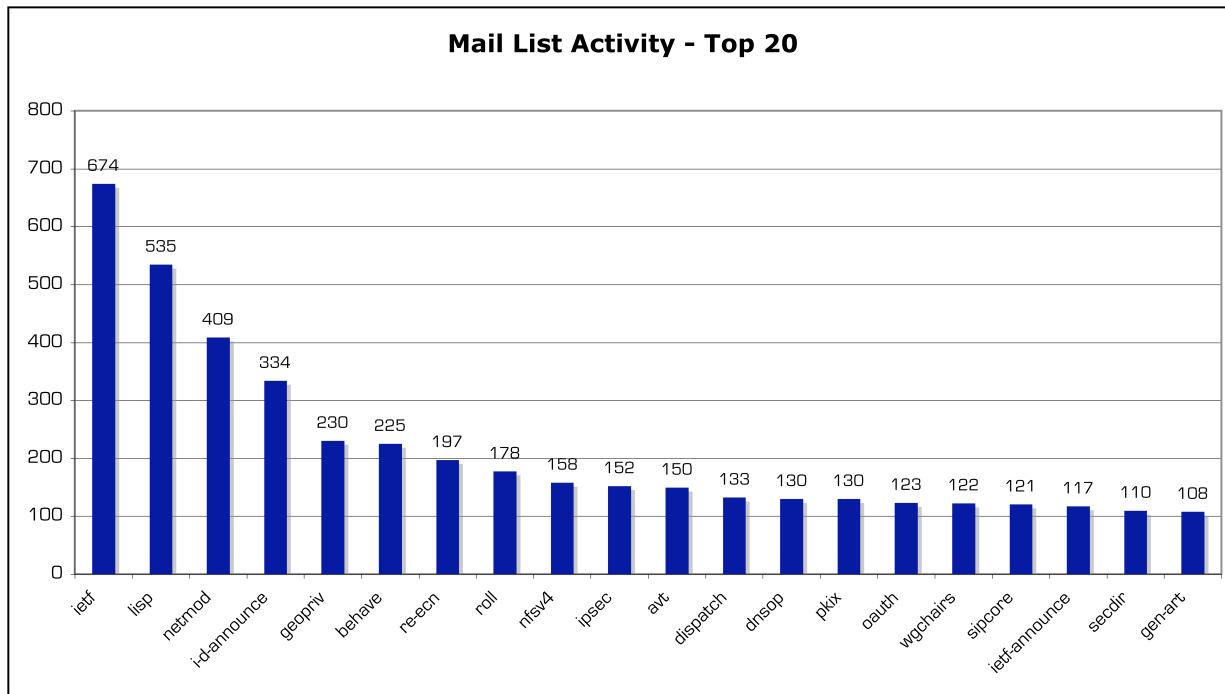
