

Announce RFC Ed Website Revamp SOW 3 Sep 14

Subj: RFC Ed Website Revamp SOW for Community Input

The IAOC intends to seek bids for a project to revamp the RFC Editor Website and desires community input on a draft Statement of Work. The SOW is located here: <<http://iaoc.ietf.org/rfps.html>>.

The community comment period ends 21 September 2014. The IAOC will consider all comments received during this period.

#### Overview

The website revamp project will update the public-facing website for the RFC Editor (<http://www.rfc-editor.org>), providing a "front door" to the RFC Series and a more easily maintained presence to the community. The RFC Editor website needs provide an easy and accessible interface to the RFC Series.

In addition to migrating the static content, the various PHP scripts used on the existing site need to be migrated into the WordPress framework. Internally, the static content will be held in a content management system (again, WordPress), which aids in maintaining the content and creating a cohesive site. The scripts that create dynamic content will be reorganized, which makes the site more secure and portable for the long term. There will be an internal cleanup that removes deprecated content from the site. This work has already started within the RFC Production Center.

All information submitted in response to this announcement is voluntary and may be used in the development of the SOW.
