1. Tools

a. Author Statistics Award

1. The IAOC issued a Request for Bids on 17 July 2016 for the development of Datatracker Extensions for Author Statistics
2. Two bids were received by the 8 August proposal deadline, IOLA, and the Spherical Cow Group.
3. The Technology Management Committee has reviewed both proposals. Questions were sent to Spherical Cow Group, and then a conference call was held to better understand the proposed approach. Instead of providing an updated bid, on 9 September 2016 the Spherical Cow Group withdrew their original bid. Technology Management Committee had no questions for IOLA about their proposal.
4. The TMC recommends that IOLA be awarded the contract for the Development of Author Statistics Extensions for the Datatracker.

Resolution
