- Paid attendance 1,370 (220 over budget)
  - Highest since IETF 63 Paris (1,432)
- Registration fees and sponsorship below budget by \$38K ( \$170K adjusting for VAT )
- No Host, five sponsors

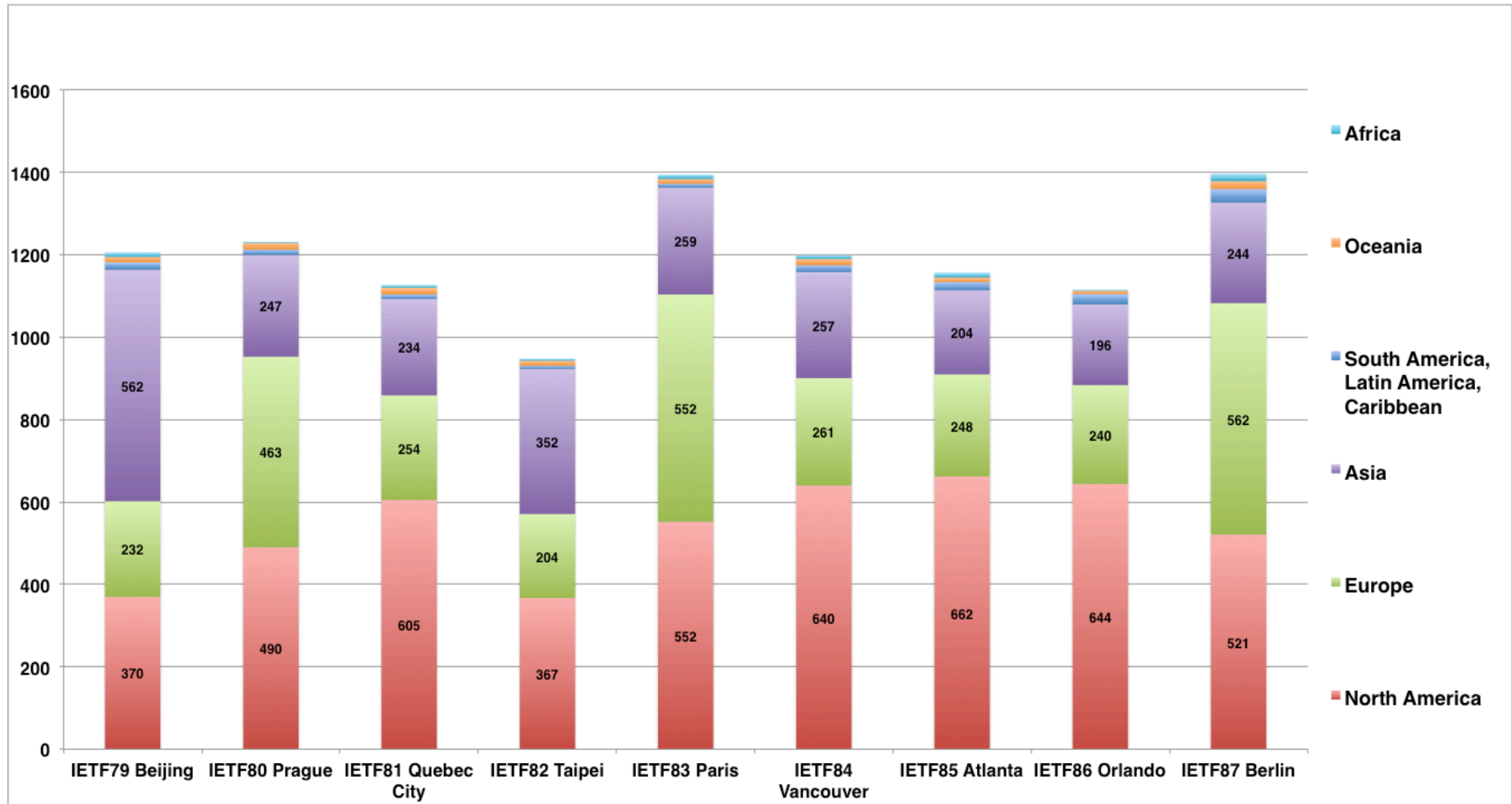
# Orlando Meeting Summary



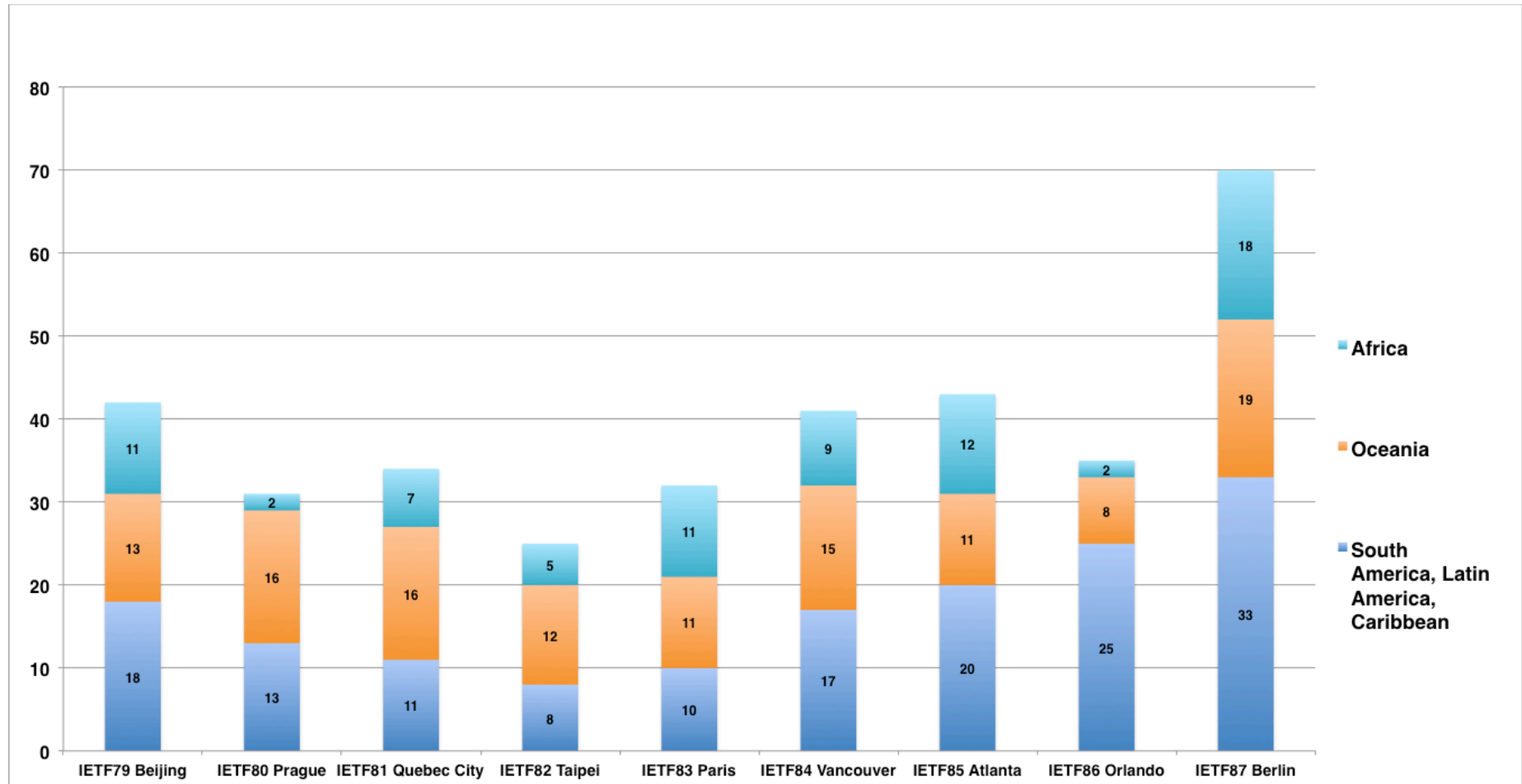
- Attendance below plan by 67 people

# South America IETF Meeting



- Site visit to Buenos Aires and Sao Paulo in February 2013
- IAOC recommend having an IETF meeting in Buenos Aires and asked community for feedback and to respond to a survey
- Based on the the feedback, survey results, and ISOC organizing local events
  - We are proceeding with planning a single meeting in Buenos Aires



# Buenos Aires Conclusions



- Survey
  - 656 Responses
  - 72.3% said they were likely to attend
  - 71.8% of active participants were likely to attend
    - Compares to 85% for London and 68.4% for Yokohama
- Community Feedback
  - A single meeting in South America isn't enough to build long term participation
    - ISOC will organize local events

# VAT in Berlin



- VAT Rules changed in the EU and Germany
- After consulting with ISOC and VAT experts
  - VAT (19%) is required to be collected on IETF Registration Fees for Berlin meeting
  - We may be able to get VAT refund on meeting expenses (Venue space, Food & Beverage, etc.)
- IAOC (with ISOC support) decided to keep total registration fee the same
  - VAT is included in announced price
  - ~ \$100K registration fee revenue reduction

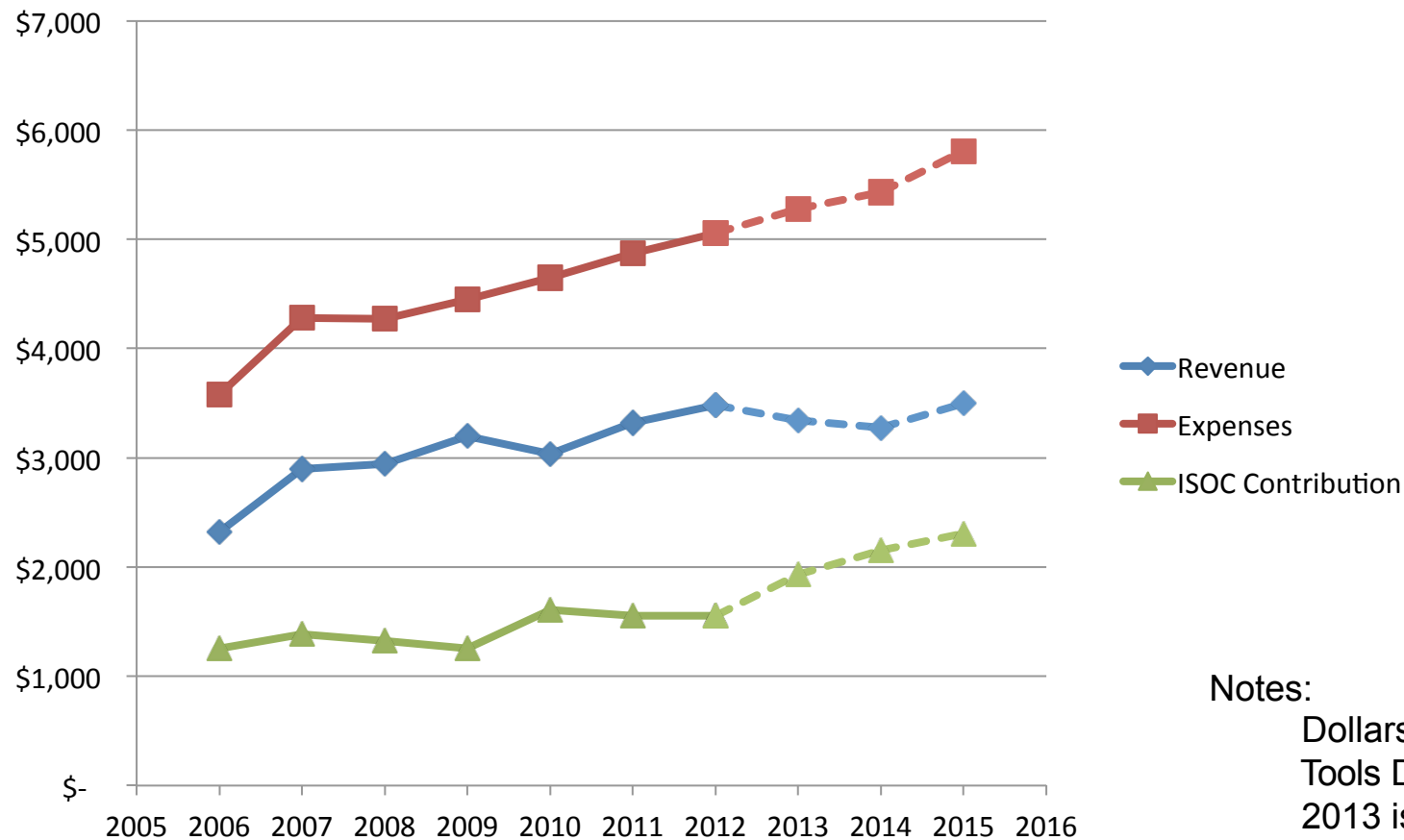
