**1. 2018 Budget**

Major differences from version 05 to 06 of the budget include:

The Secretariat has changed their breakdown of what percentage of work is meeting-related, as well as adding breakdowns for Admin, IT, and Finance.

Registration fees have not been changed for the 2018 budget but Ray recommends advising an increase from \$700 to \$775, and thereafter at a regular 3% per year.

Recommended Sponsorship targets:

2018: \$1.5M  
2019: \$1.75M  
2020: \$2M

Without any changes to registration fees and sponsorships the ISOC contribution will increase to \$3.45M in 2019

Alissa suggested adding a narrative for the numbers projected in 2019 and 2020. Particularly, a breakdown of the higher Secretariat costs should be included. Ray will work with the Finance committee to craft a narrative that could form the substance of a discussion with the community.

## **2. Followup from IESG Call**

Various members of the IAOC attended the IESG telechat on 21 September to discuss potentially charging for remote participation. The IESG is supportive of the notion of charging and recognizes there is a lot of complexity involved. The IAOC and IESG will be continuing to explore the topic but it will take a long time so likely won't affect the 2018 Budget cycle.

The IESG has discussed changing Bits-N-Bites and the Hackathon, both for IETF 100 and beyond, and will be continuing those discussions. There is not enough information yet to know what, if any, changes may need to be made for the budgets for 2018-2020. There are no Hackathon or Bits-N-Bites sponsors yet for 2018.

The position has been offered to a candidate and the agreement will be signed imminently. Their start date will be October 2. An announcement will be made as soon as possible.
