- 1 Paid attendance was 69 attendees higher than Budget forecast.
- 2 In-Kind sponsorships includes value of circuits contribution; corporate in-kind not realized as expected
- 3 Bits-N-Bites sponsors fewer than forecast.
- 4 Hackathon costs lower than forecast, thereby reducing sponsor revenue.
- 5 Hotel commissions lower than forecast.
- 6 Although in the budget, IETF 96 VAT was not booked in the revenue line item.
- 7 Food and beverage costs for Hackathon (\$22K), Bits-N-Bites (\$7K), breaks (\$20K) were lower due to lower currency valuation.
- 8 NOC contracted costs were lower (\$12K) than forecast.
- 9 Euro valuation drop from 1 Euro = \$1.38 to 1 Euro = \$1.14 accounts for the significantly lower cost.
- 10 Currency valuation reduced cost.
