- 3 a InKind Sponsorships: The value of donated services and goods associated with the meetings, plus contributions of WebEx and tools support services
 - b The variance represents the absense of a budgeted InKind corporate contribution for site visits. June actuals represent a correction for prior months' recordings between this line and Bits-N-Bites and Event Revenue lines.
- 4 a Hotel Commissions: IETF receives a commission from IETF guest rooms reserved by meeting attendees.
