

November 2010 Statement

Summary

The November statement captures the last of the 3 IETF meetings for 2010, and thus the last of the revenues for 2010. November revenues exceeded expenses by more than \$150k.

Revenues

The IETF recognized \$977k in revenues in November, second only to the \$1.1m recognized in July.

Annual revenues are \$3m, \$102k (3%) below the budget for the year. However, \$75k of that amount is in-kind and has an offsetting equal reduction in meeting space expenses.

Expenses

Expenses totaled \$820k in November, 65% of which are recognized meeting expenses for IETF 79.

The RFC Services expenses includes \$45k in total accrued expenses for the TRSE for October and November and thus are above the norm by about \$22.5k.

There is nothing unusual about the other expense items.

Note that for the first time this year the monthly financial statement has broken the category Meeting Expenses into more detail. Meeting Space has been removed from the category Other Meeting Expenses to better track this significant expense.

IT Tools Development

Expenses were low at \$12k and the projection is slightly more than \$200k in expenses recognized for the year.

ISOC Direct Contribution

The direct contribution is \$33k below expectations through November. It is anticipated that this will continue through the year.

ISOC Direct Contribution Including Development

IT Tools Development will come in under Budget by nearly \$360k for the year.
