Amendment One: RFC Publisher Extension

This Amendment amends the RFC Publisher Services Agreement dated 8 October 2009 and is entered into as of this 9th day of December 2011, by and between Association Management Solutions, LLC, a California Limited Liability Company ("AMS") and the Internet Society, a District of Columbia nonprofit corporation ("ISOC"), acting on behalf of the Internet Engineering Task Force ("IETF") through the Internet Administrative Oversight Committee ("IAOC"). AMS and ISOC are collectively referred to herein as the "Parties", and each is individually referred to as a "Party". January 1, 2012 is the "Effective Date" of this Agreement.

1. Term.

This Agreement is hereby extended for the period 1 January until 31 January 2012.

2. Payments. This section has been removed for Business Confidential reasons. The AMS fee

3. Termination of Subset of Work

ISOC may terminate this Agreement as to a subset of the Work upon ninety (90) days written notice.

4. Scale Back

For budgetary or other reasons the IETF may find it necessary to scale back on the support it receives from and the payment it makes to AMS. AMS agrees to cooperate with the IETF by recommending service cutbacks and priorities to achieve the scale back target. Further, AMS agrees to cut back such services and fees as may be agreed to in writing between the parties.
